EXTENSION: CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The National Construction Authority wishes to notify stakeholders and the general public that the call for abstracts for the 5th International Construction Research Conference and Exhibition (ICoRCE-2024) has been extended to Monday, 22nd April 2024.

ICORCE 2024 will take place in September 2024 in Mombasa County . The conference will feature a convention agenda with seminars and exhibitions on a variety of construction technologies and materials. Researchers and construction professionals are invited to submit abstracts for consideration.

CONFERENCE THEME

Leveraging the potential of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) and technology for a resilient and sustainable construction industry.

SUB THEMES

- 1. MSMEs as pillar of development;
- 2. Smart contracting for sustainable construction;
- 3. Resilient infrastructure: adapting construction to climate change;
- 4. Artificial intelligence and automation in the construction industry;
- 5. Embracing diversity and inclusion in construction.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

- 1. The abstract should be a summary of a paper's substance including research background, rationale, methodology, results, and conclusion;
- 2. Each abstract should be between 175 to 250 words and should be in the English Language, typed in Bookman Old style font, font size 12 in MS Word format. The word limit relates only to the text of the abstract and does not include title, authors, and institutions;
- 3. Each abstract should have a three-line description title which can be used in the conference brochure;
- 4. All submissions shall be made via the email: research@nca.go.ke. If you are unable to submit in this manner, kindly contact the Conference Secretariat via +254709126/102/172/173 for further information;
- 5. There is no limit to the number of abstracts that may be submitted by an individual. However, splitting a body of work into abstracts is discouraged and consolidation into one is preferred.
- 6. All submission are highly encouraged to be from concluded research work with highlights on potential areas and opportunities for commercialisation/partnership.
